RESOLUTION # 2-1-91-D

- WHEREAS: the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin joins with Indian tribes in opposing the efforts of the Wisconsin Counties Association to undermine treaties by federal legislation and other means, and
- WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Counties Association has attempted to persuade the National Association of Counties organization to join its efforts, and
- WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Counties Association has continued to use its publications and by other means to convey a negative image of Indian people and their governments, and
- WHEREAS, such negative and unnecessary acts of the Wisconsin Counties Association serve only to generate confrontation between Indian governments and their neighbors reflecting an intransigent attitude, and
- WHEREAS, in other respects, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin believes that the Wisconsin counties Association could be an agent of reconciliation and understanding between Indian and local governments.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin calls upon the Wisconsin Counties Association to repudiate any and all hostile or insensitive policies and acts of its employees and officers.
