## Resolution 2-19-82-B

### Request for BIA to Begin Trust Acquisition Process

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and

WHEREAS, Article IV (f) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available Tribal funds for public purposes, and

WHEREAS, funds are presently available for the purchase of two separate parcels of land for the purpose of constructing public assisted Tribal housing:

Beginning at the NE corner of Sec. 34, T24N, R19E; thence S0°0'0" West, 107.36 ft. along the East line of Sec. 34; thence S87°41'30"W, 215.86 ft; thence North 50°16'12"W, 288.98 ft. to the Southeasterly right of way of Green Bay and Western Railroad; thence N39°43'48"E, 432.85 ft. along the said right of way to the claim line between Indian Claim 194 and Indian Claim 196; thence South 37°32'30"E, 264.42 ft. along said Claim line to the Easterly line of Sec. 27, T24N, R19E; thence S0°2'30"E, 191.88 ft. along said Easterly line to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 3.27 acres more or less but less and excepting therefrom any lands previously conveyed for road purposes.

West 25 Rods of S 8 Rods of E ½ SE NW Sec. 24 T23N R18E 1.25 acres, and

WHEREAS, the above properties are now held in fee simple status,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process necessary to acquire the above parcel in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians.
