RESOLUTION # 2-19-93-J

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Whitney A. and Betty J. Metoxen, are holders of lease no. RL-2145(90) described as follows:

A parcel of land located within Claim 147, Section 3, T 23 N., R 19 E., more particularly described as: Commencing at the SE corner of said Claim 147 where it intersects with CTH "E"; thence N 60°W., a distance of 621.70 feet; thence N. 29°E., a distance of 369.30 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence N. 60°05' W., a distance of 130 feet; thence N 29°55'E., a distance of 84 feet; thence S 60°05'E., a distance of 130 feet; thence S 29°55'W., a distance of 84 feet, more or less to the Point of Beginning, containing .25 acres, mor or less, subject to all valid existing right-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, Whitney A. and Betty J. Metoxen, wish to modify lease as follows:


DELETE: Whitney A. Metoxen, member and Betty J. Metoxen, a non-member
INSERT: Whitney A. Metoxen, a tribal member

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Oneida Business Committee in Regular Session assembled, hereby approves the modification of lease no. RL-2145(90), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease modification documents for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
