

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the present Indian Bureau Road System on the Oneida Indian Reservation was recommended and approved by the Oneida Executive Committee as part of the Oneida Housing site and the welfare of the Indian residents thereof; and

WHEREAS, the roads in the aforesaid housing site are to be constructed by the Branch of Roads; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide a right-of-way width of forty-eight feet (as shown on site map) for these roads for takeover by the Town of Hobart for absorption into the Town Road System:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Council in Sept. 20, 1967 session assembled, that an easement for highway purposes only be granted to the United States Government, Bureau of Indian Affairs, or its assigns, as set forth in CFR 25 Part 162, and that all payment of damages is hereby waived, for the following description of tribal lands:

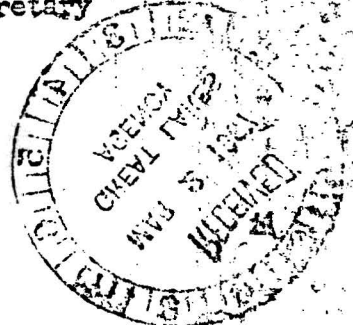
