RESOLUTION NO. 74-2-27

Because of the help of this Onida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the Colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States was made possible.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians is applying for prime sponsorship, in accordance with Section 102 (c) (1) of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians will establish a program to provide comprehensive manpower service for Tribal members in Brown and Outagamie counties to enable Tribal members to secure and retain employment at their maximum capacity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians fully intends and agrees that the development of the Comprehensive Manpower Service plan will be in accordance with the directions as specified in the Act and Regulations.
