Lot 7, Block 3, Cora House Subdivision, a part of the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 36, T. 24N., R. 19E., 4th P.M., Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, containing 1.0 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid rights-of-way of record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Committee in special session assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539) as amended: 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25-year term which shall automatically and without notice, renew for an additional term of 25 years at a total rental of $\frac{1}{2}$ Fair Market Rental-\$138.00, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are authorized to execute the lease in behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
