- WHEREAS. the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS. the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS. the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS. the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is supportive of the Oneida Community Library, both monetarily and programmatically, and
- WHEREAS. the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has the ability to provide library services for the Oneida Reservation population, and
- WHEREAS. the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin recognizes the need to expand the physical space of the Oneida Community Library, and
- the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin recognizes the need to WHEREAS. expand the library services being offered in the Oneida Community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin apply for a Library Services Special Project Grant from the U.S. Department of Education.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: this grant is asking for funds to cover renovation/remodeling of the 25' x 35' space of the past printing area for the Oneida Community Library. It will also cover furnishings to be placed in this area. There will also be some costs incurred in establishing a small library area in the Site II Community Building for a one-day per week library program. Estimated Budget: \$25,000.00 - \$30,000.00.
