

RESOLUTION 72-4-3 A

WHEREAS, Residents of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin reside in rural areas on Tribal owned, and allotted lands located in the Town of Oneida and the Town of Hobart, and

WHEREAS, The town roads adjoining trust lands serving the Indian population are in need of improvements and rebuilding to provide good roads for school busses and the Indian residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this committee in Regular session hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency to program road improvements on the Oneida Indian Reservation as indicated on the attached map.
