RESOLUTION 75-4-7-G

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Business Committee have passed two previous resolutions relevant to the Lewis or John Lewis and/or Levi Doxtator allotment as described below:

Lot 3, Sec. 6, T. 23N., R. 20E., 4th P.M., Brown Co., Wis., excepting therefrom the south 2 rods, containing 30 acres, more or less, subject to valid existing rights-of-way of record;

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe still want to obtain land acquisition to increase the area of Tribal land base and development of these ancestral tracts, thereby providing income to the Tribe; in addition, this will prevent further subdivision of a vital tract.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee hereby approves the purchase of the above described parcel with a Revolving Credit Loan made available from the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs for the interests of the Oneida Tribe and hereby authorizes the Chairman, Oneida Business Committee to execute loan application documents and that title be taken in the name of the United States of America in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that of the purchase price of \$90,000.00 Brown County be reimbursed in the amount advanced to the heirs, and the balance of the purchase price be distributed to the heirs in their proportionate shares.

CERTIFICATION
