RESOLUTION 73-5-21

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has an interest in the Emigrant New York claims award, and

WHEREAS, in the amount of \$1,496,102.45 of the award is available for reinvestment by the Bureau of Indian Affairs at a higher rate of interest than it would usually earn in the U.S. Treasury;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby authorized to reinvest the Emigrant New York funds that mature April 30 in the amount of \$367,808.76; June 7 in the amount of \$1,000,000.00; and June 18, in the amount of \$128,293.69 for an additional ninety days in Time Certificate Deposits at the highest rate of interest obtainable.

## CERTIFICATION
