WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Maxine Thomas are holders of lease no. B-1120(78), described as follows:

Lot 7, Block 2, Cora House Subdivision, located within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, Township 24 North, Range 19 East, 4th P.M., Brown County, Wisconsin, containing 1.00 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.


WHEREAS, Maxine Thomas no longer intends to use said lease site, and
