RESOLUTION TO GRANT TEMPORARY LIMITED EASEMENT TO OUTAGAMIE COUNTY FOR CONSTRUCTING A BOX CULVERT

Resolution # 5-31-95-F

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Land Committee granted a request by Outagamie County for a temporary limited easement to construct a box culvert on a tract of land in the Town of Oneida, County of Outagamie in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 24, T23N, R18E near County Highway H on May 8, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a box culvert on County Highway H is in the best interests by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin delegates two of its four officers to act in its stead as signatories to the Temporary Limited Easement for the above described property in the Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to grant the formal application for the Temporary Limited Easement to Outagamie County.
