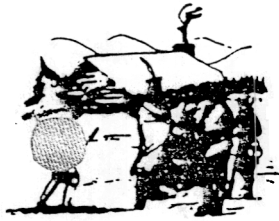

RESOLUTION NO# 6-3-86-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has constructed a hotel, known as the Oneida Rodeway Inn, and


WHEREAS, intoxicating beverages will be sold to hotel guests and to the general public for consumption on the premises of the Oneida Rodeway Inn, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has the duty and responsibility of regulating the possession, use, consumption and sale of intoxicating beverages on the Oneida Indian Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee in session hereby adopts the attached ordinance known as the Oneida Rodeway Inn Liquor Control Ordinance regulating the possession, use, consumption and sale of intoxicating beverages on the premises of the Oneida Rodeway Inn, Oneida Indian Reservation.
