WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. is engaging in the litigation of the design and structure of the Oneida Nursing Home; and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe needs funds to support this action for costs related to legal fees and design investigative reports by a qualified Consulting Architectual Engineer; and


WHEREAS, there is Tribal Operations money available through the Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs in Ashland, Wisconsin, under P.L. 93-638 funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is bound to secure a sound building for the elderly of the Oneida Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. is requesting Tribal Operations money in the amount of \$2,000 from the Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs in Ashland, Wisconsin, for the purpose of litigation against the architects of the Oneida Nursing Home.
