Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States was made possible.


RESOLUTION 6-13-95-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is charged with the duty of promoting and advancing the economic development, public welfare, and technological advancement of the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is desirous of participating in the telecommunications infrastructure of the United States as an avenue to promote the investments of the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe, through one of its tribally chartered corporations, Oneida Enterprise Development Authority ("OEDA"), is entering into a joint venture with Wisconsin Wireless for the purpose of applying to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") for licenses in the personal communication services area, and
- WHEREAS, OEDA requires a substantial injection of Tribal funds in order to participate in this investment

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves of the present and future transfer of Tribal funds into OEDA for the purposes of OEDA's participation in this telecommunication infrastructure investment.

CERTIFICATION
