RESOLUTION # 6-15-84B

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated it's responsibilities under the Oneida Constitution subject to it's power of immediate review, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Constitution provides that the Oneida Business Committee shall act for the health and welfare of it's members, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has determined that alcohol abuse has had long term negative effects on the culture and life of Oneida and other Indian people and that it should be discouraged, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has carried out a policy that neither the Oneida Tribe's resources, from any source, nor it's land, within the boundaries of the Oneida Indian Reservation, shall be used in alcohol commerce of any type, and

WHEREAS, the present laws of the federal and state governments are concurrent with the Oneida Tribe on the Oneida Indian Reservation and must be applied to non-Indians on the reservation and to non-trust land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that all activities conducted or supported by tribal resources, directly or indirectly, shall not include the sale of alcohol in any form or manner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall not affect the development of the Oneida Hotel project.
