RESOLUTION NO. 6-16-80A

WHEREAS, Acid precipitation has been identified as a potential threat to the productivity of Northern Wisconsin lakes by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the University of Wisconsin - Madison Limnology Department and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and,

WHEREAS, The electricity generating plant in the City of Green Bay, adjacent to the Oneida Indian Reservation, consumes tremendous amounts of coal which has been reported to add substantially (over 50%) to the sulfur dioxide pollution of the airshed in this area (Wis. DNR), and,

WHEREAS, Sulfur dioxides from coal combustion has been reported as the major source of acid precipitation, and,

WHEREAS, Acid precipitation can have deleterious effects on water resources, agriculture, and health (i.e., as presented by the release of toxic metals in the presence of low PH), and,

WHEREAS, There is a definite need to define the present problem concerning acid precipitation or the potential for acid precipitation problems on the Oneida Indian Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians requests that adequate funding be appropriated to establish an acid precipitation monitoring station on the Oneida Indian Reservation and to establish the capabilities to evaluate the effect of acid precipitation on the Oneida Reservation environment.
