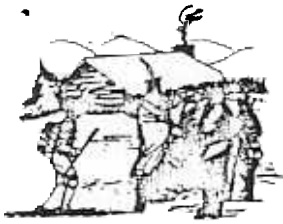

RESOLUTION NO. 7-6-77-E

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin has been given direct funding in the past, and would like to have it continued, in administering their own programs, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has utilized more effective services to their own members, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe will continue to provide information and develop new and effective changes for the provision and utilization of health services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. hereby, once again, request direct funding for the community health preventive program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Community Health Representatives are working as a team with the Health Center staff team making periodical reviews of cases; such as:

- A Reports, oral and written with the number of patients seen, the number of positive findings and number referred to other agencies for medical or dental care.
- B. Information, referrals and direction for patient care management.
- C. Evaluation from professional personnel on other programs and health care.
- D. Exchange of information with other outreach team members, county nurses, visiting nurses, physicians, dentists, social workers, alcohol and mental health counselors.
