RESOLUTION NO. 7-29-88-E


- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States ; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I, of the Oneida constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council to protect and reserve the sovereignty of the Oneida Tribe, its rights and its resources; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee, in the interest in providing quality social services to its members, family and community and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has established a Social Services division which administers Family Services; Counseling Services, Chemical Dependency, Income Maintenance, Senior Citizens, Recreation, Cannery, and Food Distribution.
- WHEREAS, The 1988 Social Services Proposal objectives of development of a group home, providing youth services and evaluation are consistent with Tribal goals and objectives.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby makes application for \$9,500 through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the period of June 1, 1988 - September 30, 1988.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman, or his delegate, of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments hereto.
