RESOLUTION NO. 8-13-82-A

WHEREAS, A Tribal governing body is eligible to apply for contracts/grants with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to plan, conduct, and administer all or parts of Bureau authorized programs, under authority of P.L. 93-638, and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that it wishes to exercise this contract/grant option by administering the FY '83 Self-Determination Grant, and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has approved the development of a Records Management System which will include the establishment of the Oneida Nation Archives for the purposes of identifying, evaluating, acquiring and maintaining documents, photos and oral records, and,

WHEREAS, This Records Management System will be administered and supervised by the Museum Director,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The scope of the Oneida Tribe's FY '83 Self-Determination Grant is to plan, conduct and administer a Tribal Records Management System,
2. The Tribal Chairman is authorized to both negotiate and execute the grant and any amendments thereto,
3. The authorities granted herein shall be effective until such time as the Tribal governing body takes further action by resolution,
4. The Tribal governing body reserves the right to review the contract/grant and any amendments thereto before execution,
5. The proposed term for the Self-Determination grant is for a period of 12 months, and it is proposed that it begin October 1, 1982 and end on September 30, 1983.
