Determination to Acquire

- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and
- WHEREAS, Article IV (f) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available tribal funds for public purposes, and
- WHEREAS, funds are presently available for the purchase of the following parcel of land:

- WHEREAS, the owner(s) of record of said property are:

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Housing Authority, Oneida Land Committee Representative and Oneida Tribal Planning Office have determined that the above-mentioned parcel is acceptable for the use of public assisted housing

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee has determined that the acquisition of the above parcel is in the best interest of the Oneida Tribe, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Planning Office be authorized to initiate and effectuate the real property acquisition process, based upon the established guidelines and procedures, and utilizing the funds allocated for this purpose.
