BUSINESS COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. 9-2-81B

WHEREAS:

The General Telephone Company, a Wisconsin Corporation, whose business address is 116 Division Street, Plymouth, Wisconsin, has made application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs through the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, a duly organized and federally recognized Indian Government, for the purpose of placing buried telephone cables on the following described lands of the Oneida Indian Reservation in Outagamie County, Wisconsin:

said buried cables to be placed within the Highway limits parallel and adjacent to the road right-of-way as surveyed and described in the attached appraisal report and plat map, and

WHEREAS:

The Oneida Tribe has resolved to grant the right-of-way, above described, pending a Bureau of Indian Affairs appraisal report regarding damages and has now received such appraisal reciting the fair market value of said right-of-way at \$920.00, and

WHEREAS:

Representatives of General Telephone and the Oneida Tribal Law Office have agreed that damages in the amount of the appraised fair market value, \$920.00, be accepted, and

WHEREAS:

Construction of telephone communication facilities are to be made with the existing and applicable Code of Federal Regulations, Federal and Oneida Tribal Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, hereby agrees to accept \$920.00 as damages for the right-of-way, shown on the attached plat map, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said right-of-way be granted to the General Telephone Company for the purpose of laying buried telephone cables on the described and surveyed parcels of land.

CERTIFICATION
