- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation (OTDC) is a Construction Contractor for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, the Home Improvement Program (HIP) is a program that upgrades the homes of tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS, the OTDC has had experience working with and administering of the Home Improvement Program; and
- WHEREAS, indirect cost if available to administer this program should be passed on through the tribe to Oneida Tribal Development Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians request the Home Improvement Program for 1981 fiscal year and direct Oneida Tribal Development to administer it.
