NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the National Congress of American Indians staff is hereby directed to accept the delegate of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin and to distribute said resolution to the appropriate offices as well as to the National Congress of American Indians membership.
