## BC Resolution # 10-14-09-E Regarding Pardon of Lila M. Denny

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee reviewed the pardon petition at a duly called public Pardon Hearing; and
- WHEREAS,** the requirements of the Oneida Pardon Ordinance and Oneida Pardon Procedures Policy have been fulfilled; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee hereby recommends approving the pardon petition of **Lila M. Denny**; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby approves the pardon of **Lila M. Denny**, Petitioner, and notifies the Oneida Nation and its employing agencies that the Petitioner is recognized as a member of the Oneida Nation to have all the benefits and employment opportunities available to all other persons as if the criminal past pardoned by this resolution did not exist.

### CERTIFICATION
