Governing Body Resolution

Whereas, in Section 1102 (a) of P.L. 95-561 the Secretary of the Interior is instructed to develop alternative methods for the equitable distribution of JOM supplemental funds; and,

Whereas, in Section 1102 (b) of P.L. 95-561 the Secretary of the Interior is instructed to conduct a ballot among the tribes and Alaskan villages, and to publish that formula which the majority of the tribes determine through their vote to be most equitable.

Now therefore be it resolved that on the 15 of October, 1979, Oncida Tribal Business Comm. (tribe or Alaskan village) governing body chose Formula Option 7 by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, with a quorum being present.
