Resolution 10-23-80B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of WI, Inc. is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under the Act of June 18, 1934, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is the governing body of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee possess the authority to contract and negotiate with the Federal Government and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is in immediate need of a data processing manager,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee request the Bureau's Tribal Managers Corps to assign a data processing manager to assist the Tribe for a period of at least one year.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee Tribal Chairman be given authority to sign any necessary documents and that the Bureau Tribal Manager Corps assume the total responsibility for the data processing manager's salary and all related expenses.
