- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:
Former Harold M. and Arlyn M. Erickson Property
- WHEREAS, the parcel is described as follows:
Legal Description: See attached.
Tax Parcel Numbers: 17-0-2197-00, 17-0-2206-00, 17-0-2209-00, 17-0-2214-00, 17-0-2215-00, HB-1294 & HB-1305
- WHEREAS, the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing agricultural land use and will not be used for gaming purposes, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Claim 134 of said Section 4; thence N 34° 38' 48" E, 1034.30 feet along the Northwesterly line of Claims 133, 132 and 135 to the Southwesterly line of lands described in Volume 261 Records, Page 336; thence S 55° 44' 28" E, 552.75 feet along said Southwesterly line to the Southeasterly line of said described lands; thence N 34° 38' 48" E, 165.00 feet along said Southeasterly line to the Southwesterly line of lands described in Document Number 1222795; thence S 55° 25' 08" E, 184.38 feet along said Southwesterly line to the Southeasterly line of said described lands; thence N 33° 44' 27" E, 320.99 feet along said Southeasterly line to the Northeasterly line of Claim 143; thence S 55° 21' 16" E, 1884.15 feet along said Northeasterly line and the Northeasterly line of Claim 142 to the beginning point of a meander line of the Westerly bank of Duck Creek, said point bears N 55° 21' 16" W, a distance of 10 feet more or less from said Westerly bank; thence S 42° 22' 22" W, 1640.59 feet along said meander line to the Southwesterly line of Claim 132 and the termination point of said meander line, said point bears N 65° 31' 27" W a distance of 35 feet more or less from said Westerly bank; thence N 65° 31' 27" W, 2429.02 feet along said Southwesterly line, Southwesterly line of Claim 133 and the Northeasterly line of lands described in Volume 887 Records, Page 76 to the Northwesterly line of Claim 133; thence N 34° 07' 43" E, 530.41 feet along said Northwesterly line to the point of beginning.
